New Ropeway Training Center for aerial tramways and funiculars in Uetendorf

Following the opening of the Ropeway Training Center in Dornbirn (AUT) in 2020, Doppelmayr/Garaventa is expanding its training offer for ropeway personnel. From May this year, Garaventa AG is providing training courses for reversible aerial tramways and funicular railways at its site in Uetendorf (CH).

Maximum safety, constant availability, top comfort. These are the features that set ropeways from Doppelmayr/Garaventa apart. Content includes fundamentals, function, wear reduction, maintenance tips and experience with a wide range of subsystems. Hands-on training plays a major role in these courses. The instructors are experienced engineers and technicians, customer support specialists and operations directors as well as external experts. Heinz Kieliger, the head of customer support at Garaventa, is very pleased about the opening of the new Ropeway Training Center: "With the Ropeway Training Center in Uetendorf, our customers will benefit from top-class training in the area of aerial tramways and funiculars, where theoretical knowledge is combined with practical implementation on real ropeway components."

Participants are accommodated at a hotel near the site. Parking facilities are available in front of the building.
